



CIHR-SRMT Collaboration Award

Application Form

AIM:

This award promotes SRMT trainees to develop new research collaborations with SRMT members. It motivates and acknowledges trainees who contribute to the field of regenerative medicine by publishing a peer-reviewed journal article or presenting an abstract at national or international conferences.

ELIGIBILITY:

- The applicants must be SRMT trainees. SRMT trainees include summer students, co-op/internship undergraduate students, graduate students, and post-doctoral fellows studying under the supervision of a SRMT investigator while conducting research pertaining to skeletal regenerative medicine. SRMT trainees do not need to be funded by the SRMT to be considered a trainee.
- When applying for an award, only one application form is required per collaborative research team. If successful, it is the team's discretion how the award is distributed amongst the team's SRMT trainees.
- This form should be submitted once the research material has been published or presented. The applicants must supply proof of publication. (For Abstracts: Conference program and attendance record; For Papers: Confirmation letter from an editor or proof manuscript.)
- Only new and emerging research collaborations will be awarded. Collaborative research teams that apply and showcase material published before July 2009 will not be accepted.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Only one application form is required per collaborative research team. Applications may be submitted to the Project Manager (HMRB300, University of Calgary; skeleton@ucalgary.ca) at any time throughout the year (January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010).

Submitted forms will be reviewed by the SRMT Training Committee. Applicants will be notified about the outcome of their application within one month of submission.

Awards will be determined based on the complexity of the collaborative research group and publication type (see Table 1). Successful teams will be responsible for determining how the award is divided between trainees within the team.
